UUNITY CIRCLE THEMES

UUNITY CIRCLES tend to be organized around a theme. An appropriate UUNITY CIRCLE theme is one that serves as a springboard into reflection on deeper issues about who we are and what gives our lives meaning.

Some of the UUnity Circle themes from last year were spirituality, creativity, life transitions, happiness, parenting, and film discussion. Other ideas have included healthy living, eco-spirituality, ethical issues, life balance, spiritual journaling/writing, meditation, living the seven UU principles, and study of religions. Special groups for people of color and young adults (age 18-35) have also been suggested.

This year, instead of listing topics or themes, we are organizing UUnity Circles in a new way. **Imagine yourself meeting in a circle with other Unitarian Universalists and friends.** What kind of themes or topics would you like to explore? What themes or topics would be meaningful to you or would help you reflect more deeply on your life?
